We warmly invite you to submit your paper for presentation in TRACK 5 **Business Ethics, CSR, Sustainability & Inclusion**, at the 12th International Research Meeting in Business and Management that will take place on **July 6-8, 2023**, at IPAG Business School, Nice Campus (France).

## WHAT IS THE FOCUS

Adopting a transdisciplinary, multi-level and critical perspective, the track calls for innovative, robust, and impact-oriented papers, addressing the new challenges and promises of Business Ethics, Responsible Governance, Corporate Social Responsibility and Inclusion at work. The track welcomes any paper (written in English or in French) providing theoretical insights and/or empirical findings to enrich the state-of-the-art and the state-of-practices in the field of Business Ethics, CSR, Social Inclusion, Gender Equality and Diversity Management. Multi-level, international and interdisciplinary articles are warmly appreciated. The track pays specific attention to the *regulation, resilience and sustainability issues* within institutions, organizations, and markets within the post-modern era. A particular focus will be devoted to the impacts of *pluralistic regulation* (sensitive to the call of stakeholders; Bruna, 2020; Rouine, Ammari & Bruna, 2022) on UN SDGs achievement, climate change mitigation and, thus, sustainable, and inclusive growth.

As a complementary key-focus, the track calls for articles addressing CSR, Inclusion and Sustainability challenges, policies, and practices in developing countries, within a particular emphasis on the African emerging economies. *In fine,* endorsing a multi-level perspective nourished by macro-economic perspective, the track welcomes manuscripts able to capture, enlighten, and assess the impacts of public policies, institutional and/or markets dynamics on sustainable development and social inclusion. Impact-oriented and societally committed, the track encourages original but robust interdisciplinary frameworks (ranging from entrepreneurship and management literature to sociology, from economics to law and philosophy of management) and supports dialogue between researchers and practitioners.
