#### WHO AND WHERE

We warmly invite you to submit your paper for presentation in TRACK # **Sustainable supply chain management (SSCM) and circular economy** organized by **Dominique Bonet Fernandez** and **Raphaël Lissillour** at the 12th International Research Meeting in Business and Management that will take place on **July 6-8, 2023**, at IPAG Business School, Nice Campus (France).

The track chairs are: **Dominique Bonet Fernandez** and **Raphaël Lissillour** (IPAG Business School, Paris), **Ticiano Costa Jordao** (Faculty of Transportation Sciences – CTU), **Maria Sylvia Macchione Saes** (Faculty of Economics and Administration – FEA/USP), and **Vivian Lara dos Santos Silva** (Faculty of Animal Science and Food Engineering – FZEA/USP).

## WHAT IS THE FOCUS

This track encourages new thinking about how Management Research addresses the numerous critical issues related to sustainable supply chain management (SSCM) and circular economy. We understand sustainability as a path with no return, a path in which new and innovative shaping solutions represent a grand challenge for our companies. At a same time to a great opportunity to move the frontier of science from the ongoing dynamics we witness. From this starting point, we invite papers bringing discussions (with theoretical contributions) on opportunities and challenges in the shaping of sustainability. We welcome submissions concerning emerging themes such as resilience (Kochan and Nowicki, 2018), circular and collaborative economy (Piao et al., 2021) in the territories (Belmonte-Ureña et al., 2021; Orengo Serra and Sanchez-Jauregui, 2022), green certifications (Lissillour 2022), social entrepreneurship (Aliouche and Bonet Fernandez, 2017), sustainable food supply chains (Ramirez-Gomez et al., 2022) and ethics (Nunes et al., 2020). There is a special interest for studies with a focus on the different forms of organizing, including technology driven supply chains (Lissillour and Ruel, 2022) and platforms (Lissillour and Sahut, 2022). We look forward to qualitative research studies based on critical (Touboul et al., 2020) and practice-based approach but also on quantitative studies on aspects including consumers' perception (Verain et al., 2021) and sustainable consumption determinant (Thøgersen, 2022). A discussion on operations and strategies perspectives is welcome.

Potential topics include, but are not limited to:

- Collaboration, tensions, and resilience in SSCM
- Interdependencies, synergies, and circular economy
- Bottom-up transition toward sustainability, sustainable consumption, and frugality
- A practice-based perspective on SSCM and circular economy
- Conflicts and alignments for the governance of sustainable systems

## WHAT IS SPECIAL THIS YEAR

This year's track# is carried out in partnership with the Czech Technical University in Prague (CTU, Czech Republic), IPAG's Erasmus project [Welcome to RESICITIES](#), the *All4Food* Network, and University of São Paulo (USP, Brazil). This will involve the participation of the following speakers: Professor Ticiano Costa Jordao (Faculty of Transportation Sciences – CTU), Professor Maria Sylvia Macchione Saes (Faculty of Economics and Administration – FEA/USP), and Professor Vivian Lara dos Santos Silva (Faculty of Animal Science and Food Engineering – FZEA/USP). The best papers will be invited to submit to a [special issue](#) of the **Rausp Management Journal** co-edited by Dominique Bonet Fernandez, Vivian Lara dos Santos Silva, and Ticiano Costa Jordao, entitled *Transition toward sustainability, sustainable consumption, and frugality*.
